## **IMPORTANT INFORMATION - KEEPING SAFE**

As we are now altogether back to full worship, with guidance from Rev. Alan, the responsible committee have drawn up the following safe procedures.

- 1. We maintain the current entry system
- 2. We maintain the one-way system
- 3. Although not mandatory, use masks in the safe seats marked rear pews
- 4. Masks can be removed when seated in the unmarked safe seats
- 5. Singing with mask on restrain volume

6. No physical contact during the service with anyone outside of your existing bubble.

For vulnerable visitors or unsure visitors, the marked rear pews will be 2m spaced.
